PROGRAM	DESCRIPTION
Family Services	Assistance with clothing, household items and basic needs. Limited dental/medical/prescription assistance.
72 Hour Emergency Food Resource	72 hours' worth of emergency food assistance and personal care needs.
Anger Management	Facilitate the 8-week Anger and Conflict Management program for required/interested individuals (\$100 fee). Child (Red Cap ages 8-12) and teen (TASK ages 13-17) programs are also available.
Pathway of Hope	An intentional approach of providing targeted services to people with a desire to break the cycle of crisis and take action to support a way out of poverty.
Homeshare	Designed to empower community members to achieve sustainable and safe housing by connecting home seekers and home sharers.
Emergency Disaster Services	Salvation Army EDS personnel respond to incidents of various sizes and scopes, and provides supports that meet the immediate, as well as long-term, physical, emotional and spiritual needs of disaster survivors and responders.
Crockpot Club	In partnership with Indwell, Community & Family Services staff teach kitchen and cooking skills to interested residents of Indwell.
Ontario Energy Support Program/LEAP	Intake agency providing assistance with applications for the Ontario Energy Support Program (OESP). LEAP program assists eligible clients with arrears on gas and hydro bills.
Community Lunch Program	Lunch served 11:30am-12:30pm on Tuesdays from May to September.
Salvation Army Camping Ministries	Weeklong (Monday-Friday) summer camp for 10 Norfolk County children at Jacksons Point (ages 6-9) or Newport Adventure Camp (ages 10-15). Moms and Kids Camp at Jacksons Point.
Backpack Program	Assisting children in Norfolk County & beyond with backpacks and school supplies.
Blanket Outreach	Offered in partnership with OEYC. Blankets are distributed at the Norfolk County Fair and included in Christmas Hampers.
Volunteer Management	Many volunteer opportunities, short term and long term. Call for details.
Community Christmas Dinner	Free, ticketed event where members of the community enjoy a Christmas dinner prepared by our staff and volunteers.
Community Christmas Program	Register and coordinate community members in Norfolk County who sponsor or require assistance at Christmas.
Christmas Hamper and Toy Program	Distribution of Christmas hampers for Norfolk County households as well as toys for children up to age 16.
Christmas Kettle Campaign/Letter Appeal	Major annual fundraiser, helps raise funds for The Salvation Army Community and Family Services Simcoe location.
Just for Kids	Kids in Kindergarten-grade purchase gift tags for \$1.00 each and "shop" for gifts for the adults in their lives and have them wrapped. Donations of new or gently used items are welcome for this program.
